Dear Members and Friends of Bethel Baptist Church:

Praise God from whom all blessings flow! As a result of the effectiveness of the COVID 19 Vaccine and the success of mitigation efforts to control the spread and impact of the COVID 19 disease, restrictions on houses of worship and other establishments have been adjusted. Our congregation's in-person worship service attendance policies and practices will be adjusted to align with local, state, and national guidelines and recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

As of May 19, 2021, New York State building capacity percentage guidelines have been eliminated. Therefore, effective Sunday, June 6, 2021, we will allow open admittance to those wishing to attend in-person worship services who will adhere to our attendance policies and guidelines while continuing to livestream our worship services. We will continue to practice and follow social distancing, hygiene, and sanitation/disinfection practices to promote the health and safety of all in attendance.

In addition, in accordance with recommendations from the CDC, fully vaccinated individuals may resume pre-pandemic activities. Those who provide proof of being fully vaccinated will have the option of being able to remove their masks or face covering during the worship experience. **Individuals who have not provided proof of vaccination must wear their mask or face covering to enter building and attend worship services. Unvaccinated individuals must wear mask while in the building and for the entire in-person worship experience.**

If you or a family member are ill or have symptoms of COVID, please do not attend in-person worship services. We advise you to continue to follow recommendation from the CDC and your healthcare physician or provider. Members with underlying medical conditions, those who are pregnant, or elderly should follow the directions of their healthcare physician or provider.

Please contact our office immediately if you or any family or household member(s) have a confirmed case of COVID 19 or come in contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID 19. You must follow any quarantine or testing requirements before attending in-person worship services.
