

- III. Saul Preaches Christ vs. 20-22
  - a. Immediately, he preached Christ is the Son of God in the synagogues
  - b. The people are amazed and confused
  - c. Saul increased in strength and confounded the Jews in Damascus
  - d. Saul through his preaching proved that Jesus is the Christ
- IV. Saul Escapes and Comes to Jerusalem vs. 23-31
  - a. The Jews plotted to kill Saul
  - b. Saul escaped by being let down through the wall in a basket
  - c. Saul tried to join the disciples in Jerusalem
  - d. Barnabas takes Saul to the disciples
  - e. Saul shares his conversion story
  - f. Hellenist attempt to kill him but he escapes to Caesarea and then Tarsus
  - g. Why do the Jews and Hellenist seek to kill Saul?
- V. The Continues to Grow vs. 31-43
  - a. Summary statement: "Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified... -- v. 31
  - b. Peter heals Aeneas vs. 32-35
  - c. Peter restores Dorcas to life vs. 36-42
  - d. Peter stays many days in Joppa v. 43
