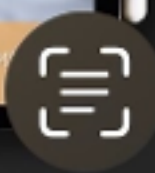
Together, they are raising four handsome boys: Isaac, Lucas, Carter, and Logan.

To God Be The Glory for the things He has done. Enjoy the many pictures of this event and the Kick-off of our Virtual Game Night presented by our eMembers.



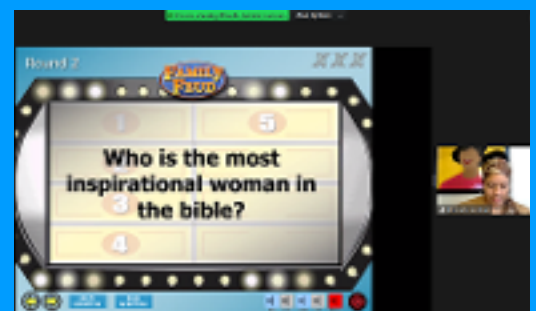
eMembers Presents Virtual GAME NIGHT

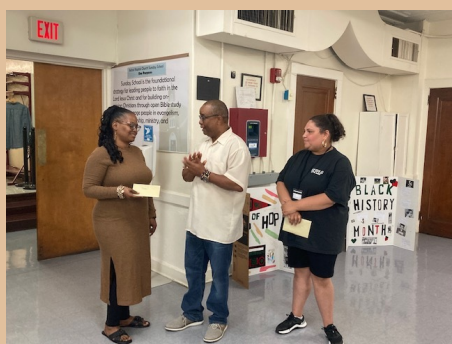

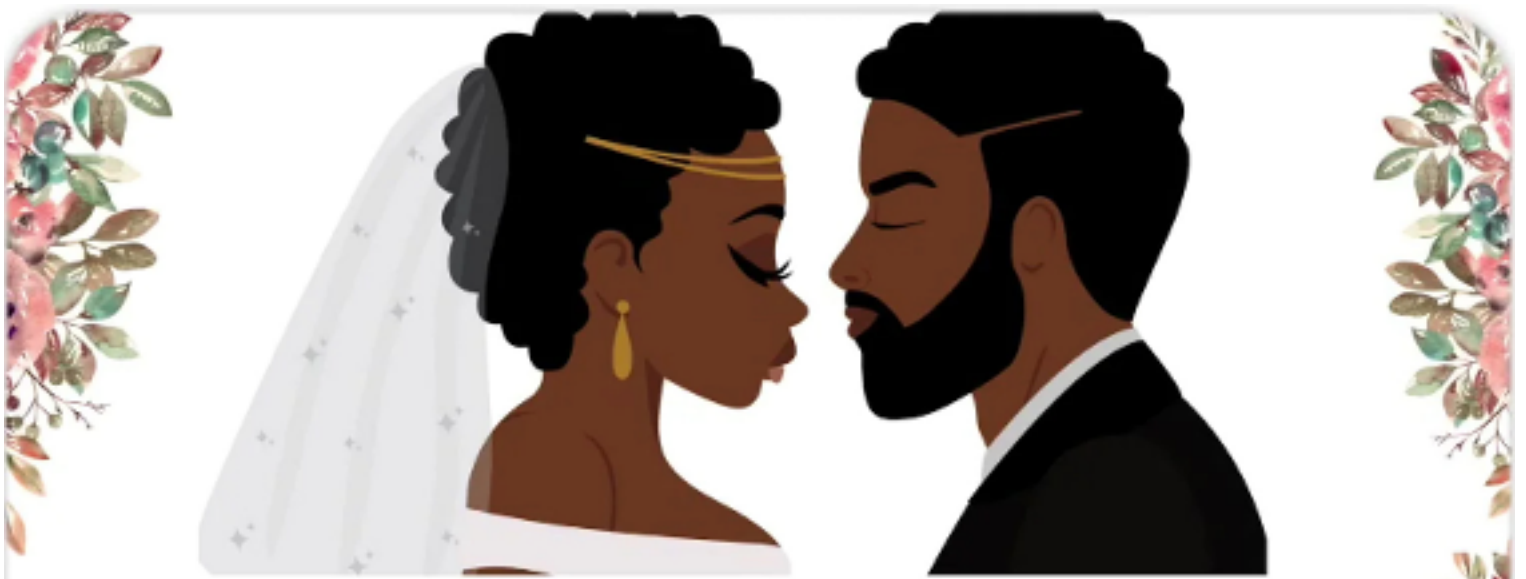

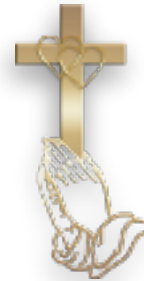
