Supplemental Information



- Daniel – captive taken to Babylon at an early age; remained true to his faith; counselor to four kings; a man of prayer; and was gifted with the gifts of knowledge, dream interpretation, and prophesy.
- Nebuchadnezzar - second and greatest king of the Chaldean dynasty of Babylon. He reigned from 605-651 BCE. He is known for his military might, the splendor of his capitol, Babylon, and his important part in Jewish history.
- Belshazzar – the last king of Babylon. He was a coregent of Babylon who was killed at the capture of the city by the Persians.
- Darius the Mede (may be another name for Cyrus the Persian)
